Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) / Criminal Damage/Crime

- Graffiti removed by wardens from BT junction box in Natts Lane
- Advice given to 2 local residents' regarding ASB and car interference.
- Graffiti reported to HDC off Newbridge Road West (Bridge)
- Suspected fraudulent big issue seller outside Sainsbury's reported to parish and *big issue*.

Parking / Vehicles

- HDC Parking Warden patrols at pick-up / drop-off time at Billingshurst Primary School are ongoing on an infrequent basis.
