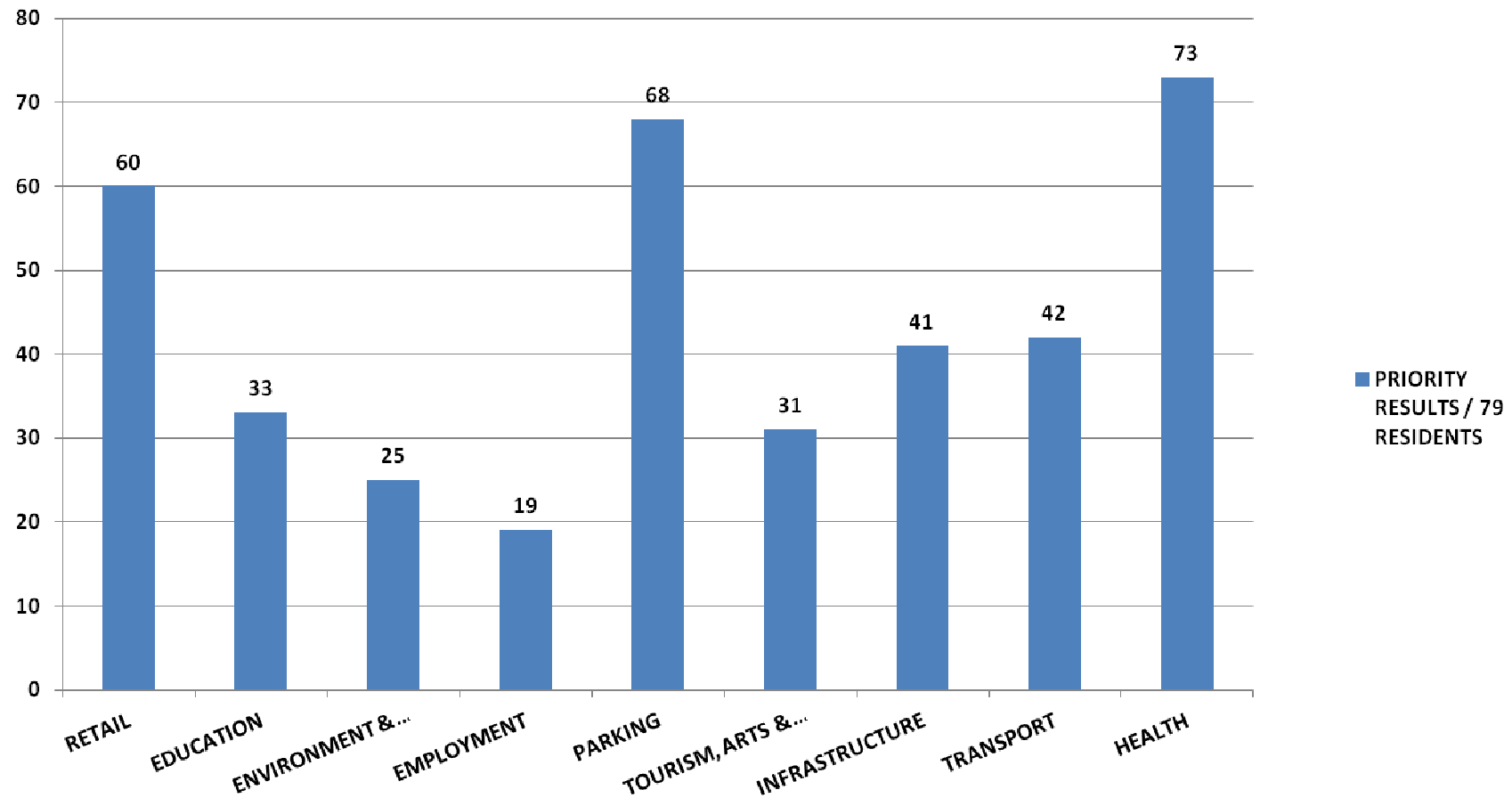

FLOWER SHOW 2016 CONSULTATION COMMENTS

RETAIL:

- More of the right shops

HEALTH:

- You can't get an appointment at the doctors!
- You can't get to see a doctor. Took 2 weeks to get to see someone.
- No medical cover at the weekend
- We need another dentist and doctors
- Health and Education are a first with all the houses being built

TRANSPORT:

- Heavy lorries and motorcycles going through the village
- Get rid of heavy lorries out of village.
- Top end of the village noisy – sound is deflected by high buildings (traffic)
- Lorries banned from Silver Lane and a 20mph speed limit.
- Mad / Bad driving in village
- I've noticed too many speeding vehicles. A danger to children and the elderly.
- Sharp corner near the Limeburners – pavement needed – Dangerous
- Marringdean Rd – 3 cars crashed in my garden since I have lived here (26 years).
- Speeding never policed.
- Petrol Station in Billingshurst
- Petrol Station

PARKING:

- Parking should be free (Jengers Mead)
- Local CPO to patrol High Street and other areas where residents abuse the yellow lines. A few tickets would solve this problem.
- Police presence on streets to monitor High Street parking and 20 mile speed restrictions

INFRASTRUCTURE:

- NO MORE HOUSES!!!
- Billingshurst doesn't have the infrastructure for more houses. We need to look after all the people that are here. Parking, Retail etc. etc. Thank you.

- Ditches need clearing in Marringdean Road
- Flooding concerns regarding the overflow stream behind Rosehill – work is urgently needed to clear this. Riparian owners have difficulty getting to this
- All pathways to Jubilee Fields need redoing
- Repair pavements and cut hedges etc to help the elderly and young children (i.e. pushchairs)
- Potholes, pavements and roads
- Litter bins at Jubilee Fields
- More bins for dog walkers around the village
- Cemetery. Definitely needed in Billingshurst.

RECREATION:

- Somewhere needed to walk near Daux Avenue
