Winter Crime Prevention Advice

Our message is to Keep A Light On

Don't let burglars know you're not home. Once it gets dark, make sure you leave a light on. The long summer days are a distant memory but make sure your property is secure with a few simple security checks.

After dark:

- Leave some lights on if it will be dark before you get home. You can buy many gadgets and devices to make it look as though you are home. But a simple timer and lamp will do the trick.
- When you go out in the evening, always leave a light on in a room that cannot be peered into from the road or path.
- Fit security lighting either dusk to dawn energy efficient lighting that will come on automatically as dusk sets in, or infrared activated lighting which draws attention to movement.

Daily security:

- Keep all wallets, credit cards and car keys out of sight and out of reach.
- If you leave your house empty, even if you are in the back garden, lock all the doors and windows.
- An intruder alarm can be an effective deterrent against burglars, seek advice to ensure it is the most suitable for your needs.
- Make it a habit to mark your valuables by using your postcode and house number or name.
- Some articles are unsuitable for marking so photograph them next to a ruler.
