Several unknown males are being seen in and around the village acting suspiciously information relating to this has been submitted x2.

Camp reported in woodland at bottom of Newbridge Road West, it was reported by neighbours that there was number of people there Sunday making a lot of noise and setting of a camp fire.

Camp found with two young males words of advice given. Tarpaulin taken down, all rubbish cleared and disposed of. 4 chairs and tarpaulin picked up by a young 12 -14 year old male, explained that camps cannot be set up especially setting of fires etc. The informant was very happy with our attendance and how it was dealt with.

Parking/Vehicles

2 vehicles moved on after being seen to park on the roundabout near to Sainsburys and advice given.

3 business vehicles seen parking on the pavement in the village, head offices contacted and managers spoken too, drivers warned any future occurrences will be reported.

6 Vehicles reported to operation crackdown for parking on the pavement and across double yellow lines in the high street or the village.

Fly Tipping/Littering/Graffiti

A number of nox bottles found in the turning point of Newbridge Road West, neighbour reports vehicles parking up down there on a regular basis but does not have description of vehicle. However, the informant will call Wardens with vehicle details when they see them.

Litter/Graffiti reported under bridge nr Newbridge Road, reported to HDC and WSSC/WSH via HDC, patrols increased in the area and resident liaised with.

- Regular patrols of Penfold Grange and Inglefield Manor.
- Regular patrols of the Daux Road area and fields at rear of the industrial estate.
- Regular patrol outside schools with teachers.
- Patrolled with traffic wardens (CEOS) and local PCSO.

Elderly and Youth

- We continue to monitor vulnerable people in the village with regular phone calls and patrols on a weekly/daily basis.
- We continue to engage with youths whilst out on patrol in and around the village.
- We engaged with young people around where they feel safe and where they don't in their villages/areas at a recent school council meeting.
