Please find attached the BSRA application for CIL funding as discussed at our last meeting. Our most recent accounts will be sent direct by our treasurer, Zoe Stone.

We have prioritised our list of improvements to those on the form, and below is an explanation of each, which we hope you find useful in considering our application. Our application is based on the increasing use of the Jubilee Fields facility as our sports clubs continue to grow with the increase in housing developments in the surrounding areas.

- Concrete Sectional Garage and Polybuild Storage Shed are required as we are now storing
 equipment outside, which presents a security and health and safety risk. We are committed to
 reducing depreciation of our maintenance equipment, and secure storage will play a key role in
 this.
- 2. Bar Room Floor Replacement is required to increase the attractiveness and modernisation of the Pavillion for hire and other revenue streams for the BSRA. We are currently obtaining quotes for this.
- 3. Goodwins Heating refurbishment needed as the system requires overhaul due to heavy use, ensuring the Pavillion utilities are suitable for the members and groups that use it and to increase its attractiveness for hire all year round.
- 4. John Deere Field Mower required for regular care of the grounds and to ensure the use of Jubilee Fields by the various sports clubs and the public can continue throughout the year in the best possible conditions. Again, storage is required to ensure that depreciation is minimal.

Thank you for your consideration. We look forward to an ongoing and productive partnership with Billingshurst Parish Council, and thank you for your support in recent times.
